LIST OF PRODUCTIVE ACTIVITIES BY JURISDICTION

The WG agreed to include in reporting only activities common across the Pacific Jurisdictions (i.e. farming and fishing). However, productive activities that have been identified (as listed below) by the Jurisdiction as potential activities that provide subsistence living to people with mental illness will be piloted for reporting (i.e. in the revised data collection tool, a third category for Employed Status such as 'Others' may be added under which a listing of these activities will be included). Based on the results of this pilot, a review and possible refinement to add more productive activities would be considered.

Marshall Islands:

- Making handicraft and sell
- Making leis (flowers) and sell
- Making copra and sell
- Gardening

Guam:

- Arts and crafts sales

American Samoa:

- Samoan Therapeutic Message
- making and selling traditional handmade crafts (i.e. traditional cooking and cleaning items, fans, woven fine mats, jewelry, Samoan art, traditional wear and accessories, Samoan twine, Samoan brooms, etc)
- tattooing
- lei making
- selling, making and selling traditional food items and Samoan Herbal Medicine
